

CAK Events FAQ's

Do you have a room/restaurant surcharge on top of the cost of food and beverage: Room surcharge is dependent upon exclusivity status, the menu offering, date/time of the event and the number of adult guests guaranteed for your party.

Will my party be in an exclusive setting: We do not have a designated room set aside for private dining events. We seat larger parties in the sunroom, which may or may not be exclusive to your party. If your party is smaller, you will be encouraged to share the sunroom with other guests dining simultaneously. CAK staff will configure the tables and use privacy screens to provide an intimate setting. This will also reduce costs such as room fee.

How many guests can you accommodate in a private dining setting: We can comfortably seat up to 48 guests in the sunroom, or up to 90 guests using the entire restaurant.

May I bring in decorations to personalize our event: We welcome most freestanding tasteful table decorations such as balloons, flowers and centerpieces to add a personal touch to your event. We do not allow glitter, confetti, banners or anything hung on walls, windows or furniture which can result in damage.

Are there time constraints for my event: Typically, we allow 2 ½ hours for private events. If you desire more time, we can customize your event with an added 30 minutes of cocktail time. This may affect pricing. The allotted time for your party will be outlined in your event contract.

I have looked over the sample menus and I'm wondering if I can change any of the menu items: We are happy to customize a menu that specifically meets your needs and/or dietary restrictions. Menu items to be interchanged will be at a similar price point.

Do you offer a kid's menu: Yes, we do offer a "kid-friendly" menu with options for children aged 10 and under. Please note, children guests do not count towards your minimum guest count.

May I bring a cake: Yes, there is a \$4/guest cake-cutting fee for bringing in your own cake. However, if you chose a dessert selection for your menu in addition to bringing in a small token ceremonious cake, we will waive the cake-cutting fee.

How will the tables be arranged: This depends on the size and style of your event. We have tried and true floor plans for most any size party, but we will certainly try to honor special requests. You will know the table set-up well in advance, so that you may plan for seating arrangements, centerpieces, etc.

Is there a charge for table linens: There is a small fee for ordering table linens if you choose to have them for your event. CAK does not use tablecloths in-house. White or white with bistro stripe cloth napkins are complimentary. Other napkin colors are available at an additional charge and vary in price. We recommend using white tablecloths for your CAK event which look the most aesthetic and compliment the room's simplistic and contemporary ambiance. They are reasonable at \$2/tablecloth. Other colors available upon request are \$8/tablecloth.

What does it mean that you are a BYO restaurant: Bring your own bottle. You are welcome to bring your favorite, wine, champagne, beer and/or spirits for your event. You will save in your overall budget, as most restaurants serving alcohol will increase your costs. We encourage you to limit offerings to beer, wine, and/or champagne.

Do you have a corkage fee: No

Do you require a deposit to hold my reservation: Yes, we typically ask for a minimum deposit of \$200 to be put towards your event once the contract has been drawn-up and signed.

Are tax and gratuity included in the prices: No, the prices quoted do not include 6% sales tax or a 20% service charge.
